THE VISION 'MERCREDI EN MONTAGNE'

Mercredi en Montagne is a movement inspired by God for the restoration of lives and families. It is grouped in prayer cells.

Through this movement, God takes a person into darkness, presents Jesus Christ to him, follows him up so he may be transformed and manifest the character of Christ. His life becomes a testimony that favors the salvation of his loved ones (family, neighbor, colleague etc.). Only the Word of God unites all the persons who get connected to this program. All the religious practices are not considered there. It welcomes anyone, believer or not, and allows everybody to continue serving God in their own church.

Under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, themes of edification are developed every month in a booklet that is multiplied and distributed for free and the Lord raises in his people a spirit of devotion and sacrifice for his glory; it is the reason why the edification meetings are held every Wednesday afternoon in the different prayer cells (Douala, Yaounde, Bafoussam, Bagangte, Bamendjou, Bangou, Ebolowa, Kribi, Garoua, Foumban, Bertoua, Edea, Kouoptamo, Baigon and Longueuil in Canada). Anyone connected to this ministry must fast and pray every Wednesday to fellowship with the group.

To spread the Gospel through the booklets and cover all the nation remains our challenge. Lives, families, couples are restored; business leaders are won over to Christ and impact their activities. Intense prayer programs multiply throughout the year to raise true intercessors. The website www.mercredienmontagne.com as well as an application 'MEM' are available. The vision progresses according to this divine instruction: **« Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back; lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes. For you will spread out to the right and to the left; your descendants will dispossess nations and settle in their desolate cities» (Isaiah 54: 2-3).**

1- I thank God for all the days of the month of May 2019 that He has created and for which He has given me grace to discover (Psalm 118: 24).

2- My soul, bless the Lord! May all that is within me bless his Holy Name! O my soul, bless the LORD, and forget not one of all His benefits! My soul blesses the Lord for all the days of May 2019 (Psalm 103: 1-2).

Like Habakkuk, stay at your post before the Lord and listen to Him. Do not be distracted but be stable, sober, humble, and patient. God has Words to reveal to you, projects to realize with you.

GOOD TO KNOW: CONVENTION ANNOUNCEMENT

WEDNESDAY, MAY 1, 2019**'GET READY FOR THE LORD'**

God is the potter and you are the clay that He uses to make the vessel useful for His house: « ***Behold, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are you in My hand, O house of Israel*** » (***Jeremiah 18:6b LSG***). Whatever your social rank, your age, your possessions, you are the clay in the hands of the potter and the goal is to make beautiful vessels that will be useful and that will give value to His house. God the potter uses His Word to shape you so that you become an honorable vessel. You who seek God and who listens to His Word, what kind of vessel are you or do you aspire to become?: « ***But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and earthenware, and some for honorable and noble use and some for menial and ignoble use*** » (***2 Timothy 2:20 LSG***). There is the vessel of gold which is solid and resists all forms of bad weather, it does not change and always keeps its brilliance whatever the place where it is. The silver vessel also resists bad weather but does not shine like gold. The vessel of earthenware and wood are quickly perishable: the wood can rot and eventually serve to light the fire and not to decorate the house, the earthenware is easily breakable. Yes, which kind of vessel are you?

The potter wants that you make yourself available for Him, in other words, to allow Him to work into your life without reasoning or resisting. You must accept the fact that the Word of God is the Truth and consider it as the plumb line that the mason uses to check if his wall is straight. In all the roles you have to play in society (parent, child, husband, employee, student, neighbor, boss, employer, man of God, etc.), you must make sure that you are on the right path: « ***Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there is any wicked or hurtful way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting*** » (***Psalms 139:23-24***).

You must make yourself available physically, spiritually and materially for the Lord because you belong to Him: « ***If we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord. So then, whether we live or we die, we belong to the Lord*** » (***Romans 14:8***). Yes, you must get prepared to obey all that God says to you because you are His property whether you are alive or dead! Stop saying 'I do not have time' or 'I cannot afford it', accept in your heart to make yourself available for the Lord and He will know how to plan your

life for you to serve Him. If you are a worker in a company for example, He is able to change your workstation or to change schedules so that you have time to evangelize, to serve Him. He has the ability to influence the decisions of your employer and to turn everything around you so that you can serve Him. The only condition is that you willingly make yourself available for Him and without constraint.

In reality you are just a vessel that He can choose to fill with all that He needs for His work. He has chosen to fill some people with anointing and He uses them powerfully to heal the sick, to restore lives, etc. He has filled some with talents: **« See, I have called by name Bezalel son of Uri, ... And I have filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom and ability, in understanding and intelligence, and in knowledge, and in all kinds of craftsmanship, To devise skillful works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in bronze, And in cutting of stones for setting, and in carving of wood, to work in all kinds of craftsmanship» (Exodus 31 :2-5 LSG).** Other vases were filled with silver. God is sovereign, He does as He wants with whom He wants but, prepare yourself for Him. Give God time, possessions, money, because you are just the vase and if necessary, He must use what He has put in you. When Jesus needed the donkey, He sent His disciples, saying: **«If anyone says anything to you, you shall reply, The Lord needs them, and he will let them go without delay» (Matthew 21:3 LSG).**

Be careful! Get prepared quickly before He decides as He did with Jonah, He has many ways to cause what He put in you to work.

Prayers:

Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I am preparing to be the vessel of honorable use in your house. I recognize that you are the potter and I accept to let myself be transformed by your Word. Alive or dead, I believe that I belong to you. Without murmuring, I give you my time, my talents, my possessions. Amen!

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WEDNESDAY, 8 MAY 2019**'GOD WANTS YOU AT YOUR POST'**

Seeking God is more than praying and meditating the Word of God. It's to enter into a pure and stable relationship with Jesus Christ and work to maintain it at the right level. You can pray and read the Bible every day but without developing a deep relationship with God. You must get into the intimacy of God and maintain this intimacy by remaining faithful to the post until death: ***«I will stand upon my post of observation and station myself on the tower or fortress, and will watch to see what He will say within me and what answer I will make to the perplexities of my complaint against Him. And the Lord answered me and said, write the vision and engrave it so plainly upon tablets that everyone who passes may read as he hastens by» (Habakkuk 2 : 1-2)***

Your post does not represent the geographical place where you stand every day for your devotion, because you can be present with your body but absent in spirit. How often do you find yourself in moments of prayer and worship just with your lips, while your heart is absent; you had no divine connection. Many times, during family's devotion or time of personal prayer, you have been absent although physically present. Your post is your place of communion with God, where you are dealing with Him intimately and no human ear can hear your conversation: It's YOUR HEART ***«Keep and guard your heart with all vigilance and above all that you guard, for out of it flow the springs of life » (Proverbs 4 :23).*** Yes, keep your secret place, your place of appointment with the Holy Spirit, your heart. May your spirit always be in communion with the Holy spirit. Preserve this relationship and ensure that it is stable. Stay at the post!

Indeed, God created all that exists and found it good to dwell in your heart. Among all the other creatures, He chose to live in Man, what a grace! ***«Do you not discern and understand that you are God's temple, and that God's Spirit has His permanent dwelling in you?» (1 Corinthians 3:16).*** You must know that there is one seat in your heart, reserved for God alone. It must be occupied only by the Holy Spirit and if it is not the case, you will experience emptiness in your life that you will seek to fill by all means without being satisfied. Some people engage in alcohol and drugs; others work too much or eat a lot; there are sex addicts; passionate lovers ready to kill each other if their relationship break down; Some phenomena of extreme fanaticism; Very angry people; In short, we notice different forms of addiction that are

due to the absence of God in the heart of man. The peace of the heart, the satisfaction of man is perfect only when the Holy Spirit comes to settle there.

At the post, you are in a state of spiritual watch, you become the sentry who watches day and night. You now pay attention to every act you do, every word that comes out of your mouth, your environment. In short, like Habakkuk, you are at the post in perfect unity with the Holy Spirit and you are attentive to the least Word that rises in your heart: **« *I will [in my thinking] stand upon my post of observation and station myself on the tower or fortress, and will watch to see what He will say within me and what answer I will make to the perplexities of my complaint against Him* » (Habakkuk 2 :1).** God speaks a lot in the heart of man but distractions move Man away from the post and he does not catch anything.

The prophet Habakkuk gives you the attitudes you need to develop to stay faithful to the post and receive instructions from God: You must first make the decision to stand at the post, it means that that you prepare yourself to listen to God and to obey him promptly. It requires a real commitment (body-soul-spirit). Then you remain standing, it means to stay in service, refusing any laziness. You are attentive to the voice of the Holy Spirit who will speak in your heart with a word that you will receive and which will mark you in a particular way. You must open your Bible every day and desire a word that will enlighten you all day long. At the post, God answered Habakkuk saying to him: **« *Write the vision and engrave it so plainly upon tablets that everyone who passes may read as he hastens by* » (Habakkuk 2:2).** When you receive from God, write it, pray about it and share it.

Prayers:

Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I believe that my body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. I remain at the post, connected one hundred percent to the Holy Spirit. I make sure to maintain a pure and intimate relationship with you. Amen!

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WEDNESDAY, 15 MAY 2019**'WATCH YOUR INTIMACY WITH GOD'**

Watch ! It is a recommendation that Apostle Paul used to make to the Christians to whom he had preached the gospel. He understood that to open one's heart to Jesus Christ is the beginning of a process and that it is vital to watch spiritually in order to detect all the subtle attacks of the enemy: **« Be alert and on your guard; stand firm in your faith. Act like men and be courageous; grow in strength » (1 Corinthians 16:13).**

To watch is to pay attention to your daily doings which may give strength to the devil to act in your life. Your body is to be watched in the same way as your soul and your spirit because they are all in the service of the Lord: **« The body is not intended for sexual immorality, but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body » (1 Corinthians 6:13b).** Let the Word of God enlighten your whole body, then watch: **« If then your entire body is illuminated, having no part dark, it will be wholly bright, as when a lamp with its bright rays gives you light » (Luke 11 :36).** Know also that everything in you is done for the glory of God. Your mouth must not say anything, it must honor the Lord: **« Let there be no filthiness nor foolish and sinful talk, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting or becoming; but instead voice your thankfulness » (Ephesians 5:4).** Know that with your mouth you can defile your life : **« It is not what goes into the mouth of a man that makes him unclean and defiled, but what comes out of the mouth; this makes a man unclean and defiles him » (Matthew 15 :11).** Now, pray as follows: *'Father, in the name of Jesus, I implore your mercy upon my life and upon all those who destroy their lives with bad words that come out of their mouths. By the blood of Jesus, I cancel all these words and I sanctify my mouth, I overthrow every altar built in my life because of the bad words that have come out and I cancel all their influences on me and my family'.*

Your ears too should not listen to anything (gossip, unhealthy music, diviners, etc.). Even your eyes do not have to see anything (pornography scenes, movies that advocate evil, etc.); You should often raise this prayer when you hear bad words or you see what is not good: *'In the name of Jesus, I command my memory to erase everything wrong I have heard or seen. With the blood of Jesus, I destroy all evil thoughts related to what I*

*have listened to or seen and I cast out all evil spirit that connects me to foreign gods'. In any case, you have to make sure that all the parts of your body are not gateways to evil spirits; that is living a healthy life, spiritually and physically. If you seek God, you must not play with your body: « **Do you not see and know that your bodies are members of Christ? Am I therefore to take the parts of Christ and make [them] parts of a prostitute? Never! Never!** » (1 Corinthians 6:15).*

Above all, you must watch over your heart which is the source of everything: « **Keep and guard your heart with all vigilance and above all that you guard, for out of it flow the springs of life** » (Proverbs 4:23). How to keep your heart? You must pay attention to the feelings your heart expresses. If you feel a hint of jealousy, anger or lust towards someone for example, immediately raise a prayer: *'In the name of Jesus, I repress and reject all spirit of jealousy, anger, lust in me and I proclaim love'.* You must make sure that your heart keeps nothing wrong. If a desire contrary to the will of God rises in you (desire for sex when you are not married, desire for alcohol or drugs or the desire to watch an erotic film, the desire to hurt, etc.) you must immediately declare *'Get behind me, Satan'* and pray as follows: *'Holy Spirit, in the name of Jesus, neutralize in me all carnal desire that drives me to immorality and all forms of sexual vice, annihilate in me all the works of the flesh ' . 'I command evil spirits (list their names) to come out of my body now in the name of Jesus'.*

Habakkuk the prophet sought God and did not allow himself to be distracted by the circumstances and events of life. He said he was at his post and was watching, his heart was willing to listen to God and Him alone. The heart of Habakkuk was prepared to listen to God. Yes, the Lord wants you to work to maintain your heart holy and in a spirit of listening.

Prayers: *Everyone with his words must examine his life and pray.*

WEDNESDAY, 22 MAY 2019

'WAIT ON THE LORD IN ALL THINGS'

God wants you to be fully available for Him; in other words, that you consecrate yourself to Him, body, soul, spirit. He is not a man you can juggle, even if you have the impression that He is silent, He sees everything, He knows everything, He is Spirit!

« *For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth to show Himself strong in behalf of those whose hearts are blameless toward Him* » (2 Chronicles 16 :9). Is your whole heart devoted to God? What occupies part of your heart, as small be the thing? « *...You must love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind* » (Luke 10:27a). The deep meaning of the word ALL that is quoted many times in this verse simply means that you not only trust in God but you rely on Him and you expect his interventions.

Indeed, God the Father wants you to be totally submissive to him. He wants to focus your attention on Him, the only one who can fill you. Ask yourself these questions:

- Have you made God your support? To rely on God is to trust Him by resting on Him, on His Word, on His instructions. It is to make His Word your reference: « *Some trust in and boast of chariots and some of horses, but we will trust in and boast of the name of the Lord our God* » (Psalm 20:7). King David had only God as support, when going through difficult times, he continued to rely on God: « *David was greatly distressed, for the men spoke of stoning him because the souls of them all were bitterly grieved, each man for his sons and daughters. But David encouraged and strengthened himself in the Lord his God* » (1 Samuel 30:6). David would not rely on his riches, nor his position as leader, nor on his strength as a warrior; he would rest on God and get the courage to move forward. « *Blessed is the man whose strength is in You* » (Psalm 84:5a). The Lord draws your attention to a very subtle fact: when situations occur to you, of what do you think immediately? Of a relationship that can help you? Or a word of God that comforts you? To surrender oneself to God is to accept to rely on Him in all circumstances and to trust Him completely.

- On whom do you wait? Christian life is made of waiting: « *I wait for the Lord, I expectantly wait, and in His word do I hope* » (Psalm 130:5). You

are certainly waiting for the physical fulfillment of one of the many promises God has made in your life. You are convinced that He will do what He has promised, but you have the gaze fixed on your surroundings to see the thing happen; You are waiting for a spouse and you spend time examining the behavior of anyone around you; You are waiting for healing but you are focused on the doctors to see who will prescribe you the miracle drug; You are waiting for a job but you are focused on the men who can hire you; You are waiting for the deliverance of your child but you analyze point after point his behavior in everyday life. Like the apostles, you ask yourself about the time of fulfillment. God says to you, **«It is not for you to become acquainted with and know what time brings or fixed years and seasons, which the Father has appointed by His own choice and authority and personal power» (Acts 1:7)**

God is saying to you today: you must not be stuck on time or circumstances, but you must expect Him who has the ability to accomplish what He promises. Without a doubt, God is faithful. You do not know how, or when, but He says and He fulfills. Wait on Him! There was ONE DAY for the lame and beggar sitting in front of the temple; there was ONE DAY for the sick man lying at the pool of Bethesda; there was ONE DAY for Bartimaeus blind and beggar; there was ONE DAY for the woman with the flow of blood: THIS DAY came as a surprise, none of them had envisaged such a turnaround of their situation, they were all desperate, but God has performed their miracle. God wants you to expect Him. Look away from all that is physical and focus on the spiritual, on His Word; prove that you have faith in God. Reality can distract you, the truth will always reassure you.

Prayers : Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I proclaim that you are faithful, I look away from all that is physical, about my circumstances and I focus on your Word which is the Truth. I decide to rely on You, I trust you and I expect you. Amen!

NOTES

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TEACHING OF THE MONTH: THE COUPLE

1- The unity of the couple is a formidable weapon against the devil

A united couple responds to the Word of God that declares: **«...man shall leave his father and his mother and be joined to his wife and cleave closely to her permanently, And the two shall become one flesh, so that they are no longer two, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate» (Mark 10:7-9).**

God is committed to the unity of the couple. By His Word, He has already established it in the spiritual realm and whoever appropriates this word lives unity in his couple. When the 'Yes' is declared by both spouses, a covenant is made and henceforth God sees one person and not two.

Breaking this instruction is to deny God and honor the devil. Respecting this Word, is to put the devil to shame and keep him away from the couple. God blesses united couples and protects them from danger because they obey Him. Whatever difficulties the couple may face, both spouses must wait on God by regularly proclaiming this word of Mark 10: 7-9.

Prayer: Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I submit to you my couple and the other couples (call their names), I believe that my spouse and I are 'one' according to what is written. I believe nothing will separate us and our covenant is sealed by the blood of Jesus Christ and marked with the seal of the Holy Spirit. That's why I take authority in the name of Jesus Christ, and I cast out of my home all spirit of division, quarrel, sexual immorality, jealousy, covetousness. I proclaim the reign of God in every aspect of my relationship in the name of Jesus Christ.

2- The prayer of the couple is efficient

« Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor; For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow. But woe to him who is alone when he falls and has not another to lift him up! » (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 LSG). It is better to live as a couple, walk together, build together. If one spouse weakens or falls, the other will raise him first by prayers and then physically. Prayer as a couple helps to support each other, to strengthen each other and develops a great intimacy in the couple. Moreover, it is written: **« Again I tell you, if two of you on earth agree**

about whatever they may ask, it will come to pass and be done for them by My Father in heaven. For wherever two or three are gathered in My name, there I AM in the midst of them». The couple's prayer establishes the reign of God in the home (peace, joy, love can now be powerfully shown by both spouses).

Exhortation: The couple's prayer consolidates the home, strengthens love and keeps the home in a true peaceful atmosphere. It protects the couple from the onslaughts of the enemy. God strongly recommends it to you, obey and you will see the glory of God.

PROCLAMATIONS FOR THE FAMILY

It is important as a child of God to make proclamations according to the Word of God. We propose some proclamation points for your family (couple and children)

Proclaim in the name of Jesus Christ

- I confess that Jesus Christ is Lord of my family and I choose to invoke His name and to worship Him with my family, my spouse
- I place my family, home, and everything I have, under the authority of the Word of God and I declare that it influences the character and life choices of my family and home members
- I declare that my family is fruitful, prosperous spiritually, materially, financially, socially, etc.
- I proclaim that Christ is the pillar of my family, of my present/future home and of all other families and I cover them with the blood of Jesus;
- I proclaim physical restoration in the homes and families of the movement;
- I proclaim that my present/future children do not turn away from God's plan for them and that they make their parents glad;
- I separate my children from bad friendships and I disconnect them from any worldly spirit;
