THE VISION 'MERCREDI EN MONTAGNE'

Anyone connected to this ministry must fast every Wednesday to fellowship with the group and pray.

To spread the Gospel through the booklets and cover all the nation remains our challenge. Lives, families, couples are restored; business leaders are won over to Christ and impact their activities. - 1- I thank the Lord for the month of August 2019. It is another grace for me to live the glory of God and its manifestations in my life in this blessed month.
- 2- I recognize that God is faithful, He watches over His word to perform it (Jeremiah 1: 12). The good words spoken about my life see their fulfillment in this month of August 2019 in the name of Jesus Christ.
- 3- The Lord is alive, the Holy Spirit is at work; He brings every good work of my life to perfection in the name of Jesus Christ (Philippians 1: 6).

PROCLAMATION FOR THE MANIFESTATION OF THE DIVINE NATURE

- « What is born of the flesh is flesh; and what is born of the Spirit is spirit» (John 3:6). Jesus Christ mentions two types of birth (by the flesh and by the Spirit); in other words, human birth and divine birth. It is a matter of positioning oneself and manifesting the divine life through the proclamation of the following verses:
- 1- I am redeemed for God by the blood of Jesus Christ. I have become a king(a queen) and a priest, I reign on the earth with Jesus Christ the King of Kings (Revelation 5: 10).
- 2- I am heir of the divine nature by the Holy Spirit who lives in me. I am united to the Lord and I form one spirit with Him (1 Corinthians 6:17).
- 3- I have become by the power of God, and by the Holy Spirit who lives in me, partaker of the divine nature. I show the character of Christ. I am a written letter from Christ (2 Corinthians 3: 3).
- 4- I am a new creation in Christ; the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come! (2 Corinthians 5:17).
- 5- I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me (Galatians 2:20a)
- 6- I am born of the Spirit (John 3: 6) and I let myself be led by the Spirit of God (Romans 8:14)
- 7- The law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has freed me from the law of sin and of death (Romans 8: 2)
- 8- My influence decreases and that of Jesus Christ increases. Christ is seen and I am effaced (John 3:30)

KEY MESSAGE OF THE MONTH OF AUGUST 2019

'Remember His Word'

The walk in the Spirit is supported by the Word of God; outside of this setting, it's divination. So you must rely on it, remember every word that God has revealed to you, in order to stay on the path: God speaks sometimes in one way, sometimes in another (Job 33: 14-15); what is certain is that He speaks! When you really seek Him and you get ready to listen to Him, He gives you a Word for every good work that you have to perform. You must remember that revealed Word and meditate on it incessantly, ponder it, consider it in order to remain in His perfect plan: *«Remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee » (Luke 24:6b)*. This is the answer of the angel to the worries of the women who went to the grave of Jesus and did not find Him. Remember all the words that the Lord has spoken to you. The Holy Spirit fulfills nothing without the revealed word.

'GOD AND HIS WORD'

od is faithful to His Word. He has demonstrated through several verses in the Bible that He attaches great importance to His Word: « for I will hasten my word to perform it» (Jeremiah 1:12b). He watches over what He said about your life, He is vigilant for every detail and He makes sure that what He said for you is coming true. When His promise seems to be delayed, He reassures you; He is never late or early, He is the master of times and circumstances. He said to Prophet Habakkuk: « ... Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry» (Habakkuk 2:2-3). Prophecy is a word that God announces to you concerning any area of your life. He asks you as to Habakkuk, to take it seriously, to engrave it in your heart and on a support so that it may be read because it will serve as a testimony the day it will be fulfilled. You will have to remember the day God spoke to you and realize all the work done by the Holy Spirit in the process and all the events that contributed to the fulfillment of the prophecy. This is very important for the testimony.

You can receive the Word of God and wait a long time before seeing its fulfillment; the truth is that God does not lie; never doubt what He said to you: "God is not a man, that He should lie; neither the son of man, that He should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?" (Numbers 23:19). God is a serious and responsible Father: when He promises, He gives. How many times have you made a promise to your child or to someone else and you did not respect? God is by far comparable to a man. He keeps His promises: "The Lord of hosts has sworn, saying, "Surely, as I have thought and planned, so shall it come to pass, and as I have purposed, so shall it stand!"" (Isaiah 14:24 AMPC).

All started with the Word: *« In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God Himself.» (John 1:1 AMPC)*. God does not work without His Word. He created the earth and all that is on it by that Word: *«Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by*

the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear» (Hebrews 11:3).

<u>Understand that it is the Word of God that triggers ALL divine process in your life</u>. For example: *« And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.» (Genesis 1:3).* The Word of God caused the production of light on earth. God just needs to speak: *« For He spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast» (Psalm 33:9).*

If there is one thing that should rejoice your heart, it is the Word of God. It's the starting point of EVERYTHING. When you receive a Word of God, do a thanksgiving, celebrate God for what He has said, because it is certain. He said to the king's officer, *«...Your son lives»* (John 4:50a), this man believed in the word that Jesus told him and it was fulfilled. You, believe and prove your faith by giving thanks to God, celebrating Him for His Word. Mary the mother of Jesus did not discover her pregnancy while waking up: it was necessary for God to send the Word through the angel Gabriel, she had to believe in this word and receive it in her heart. This Word created what it said: Mary conceived Jesus of the Holy Spirit, exactly as God had said (Luke 1: 26-36).

What consideration do you give to the Word of God? Reposition it in your Christian life, take it seriously and like God, give it a great importance. Early in the morning, try to listen to the Word of God, be hungry for the Word: it's what nourishes you and allows you to grow spiritually. Take time every day to read the Bible and meditate the word you receive. God and His Word form ONE. He is faithful, be also faithful to live a true intimacy with Him.

Prayer:

Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I give you thanks for the life that you distill through your Word. It is now my daily bread, I decide to read the Bible and meditate on the Word I receive; I also put it into practice in all areas of my life. Amen!

'REMEMBER THE WORD OF GOD'

he new creation, the one that exists by faith in Jesus Christ, must realize what it has actually become in Christ. In other words, if you are united to Jesus Christ, you must be aware of your new life and its principles: « For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God » (Romans 8:14). The work now for yourself is to pray to be aware of what you have become in Christ. You must imperatively let yourself be led only by the Holy Spirit and no longer by your feelings and emotions, your plans that have no spiritual support, your relationships: « [That is] because the mind of the flesh [with its carnal thoughts and purposes] is hostile to God, for it does not submit itself to God's Law; indeed it cannot. So then those who are living the life of the flesh [catering to the appetites and impulses of their carnal nature] cannot please or satisfy God, or be acceptable to Him.» (Romans 8 : 7-8 **AMPC).** So you must let the Holy Spirit lead you on the way that the Father has made for you. Now the Holy Spirit works with the Word of God: « And take the helmet of salvation and the sword that the Spirit wields, which is the Word of God.» (Ephesians 6:17). The Word of God is the sword of the Holy Spirit!

« The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever» (Isaiah 40:8). Indeed, anything that nourishes your flesh (grass) can dry, can end because it is perishable. The flower (which is the object of your beauty, your physical appearance) can fade, what makes your pride can lose its value because all is vanity. The only thing that does not change, that does not go out of fashion and that remains current and standing, is the Word of God: the Word made flesh, Jesus Christ. This is why He is called 'I am'; the Word is still topical. Jesus Christ spoke the word of Prophet Isaiah in the New Testament: «The sky and the earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away» (Luke 21:33). The only thing that will live forever and always be a strength for the Christian is the Word of God. Hang on to it, make body with the Word, make it your compass, you will not fail. Trials will pass and you will stand, worshiping God with joy and sincerity of heart.

That's why you should keep every Word that God has said to you in remembrance, meditate on it and proclaim it. These words must be

inscribed in your heart and noted as a reference in your projects. Your decisions must relate to what God has said. While Jesus Christ was walking with His disciples, He spoke to them in person about His death and resurrection; they heard it clearly but did not keep it in their hearts. Even Peter had received the revelation of Christ: « He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God. And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven. And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven» (Matthew 16:15-19a), Jesus Christ decided to build His Church on the revelation that the Father made to Peter! What a grace! But Peter forgot everything when the trial occured..

How many times have you made decisions contrary to God's revelation for your life? He tells you, for example, not to come again with unbelievers under a different yoke (2 Corinthians 6:14) but you insist on marrying a pagan. Ignoring the revealed Word of God is a source of repeated blockages or failures. When you are a child of God, born again and you do not conform to what God says, you cannot blossom, you become unhappy and unproductive. The women who went to embalm the body of Jesus were filled with sadness when they found the tomb empty! The angel had to come to remind them of what Jesus Christ had said to them: "Remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee " (Luke 24:6b). Beloved, remember the Word that God said to you, walk with it, rely on it, do not look at time. When trials come, tell the situation what God said!

Prayers:

Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I remain attentive to your word, I keep it in memory, I rehearse it and I make it my support. Amen!

'THE WORD OF GOD AND YOUR DESTINY'

ou are called to fulfill the glorious plan that the Lord prepared for you long before you existed: *«For those whom He foreknew, he also destined from the beginning to be molded into the image of His Son, that he might become the firstborn among many brethren. And those whom He thus foreordained, He also called, He also justified. And those whom He justified, He also glorified» (Romans 8:29-30)*. As a called to God, a glorious destiny awaits you. But how will you know it if you do not read the Bible? If you do not seek revelation? You will not fulfill your glorious destiny until you have the Word revealed by the Holy Spirit. You can move forward but with a lot of trial and error.

It is written, *«The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple» (Psalm 119:130).* Revelation is the discovery of a divine word concerning your life. It may be presented as an instruction from God: *«As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, 'Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them'» (Acts 13:2).* The Holy Spirit can reveal to you directly or through the brethren (very often when you are not attentive), a Word of God for your life. You just have to be convinced of it and obey it. With the revelation contained in the above verse, Apostle Paul got up and served God in a remarkable way. He could say to himself, 'God has set me apart' and this Word would strengthen him wherever he went. This Word would carry him above his various adversities: he would remember it and regain his strength. He would always begin his epistles with this Word: *«Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God » (Colossians 1:1a)*.

You can receive a revelation from God without necessarily being at the peak of your relationship with Him. This was the case of Abram, without really knowing God, he received a quite strong revelation: « Go for yourself [for your own advantage] away from your country, from your relatives and your father's house, to the land that I will show you. And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name famous and distinguished, and you will be a blessing. And I will bless those who bless you [who confer prosperity or happiness upon you] and curse him who curses or uses insolent language toward you; in you will all the families and kindred of the earth be blessed» (Genesis 12:1-3 AMPC).

This instruction which is a divine revelation followed Abraham all his life. From time to time, the Lord would remind him of it, to encourage him. Likewise, the Holy Spirit can remind you of what God has said to encourage you to move forward. The revealed Word sustained Abraham and his ministry during all his life on earth: "Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations; according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb: He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform" (Romans 4:18-21). The destiny of Abraham was related to the acceptance of the revealed Word of God on his life from his call and to his faith.

Prophet Jeremiah is a model of fulfilled destiny in faithfulness to the Word of God. The Lord calls him and tells him, *« Before I formed you in the womb I knew [and] approved of you [as My chosen instrument], and before you were born I separated and set you apart, consecrating you; [and] I appointed you as a prophet to the nations» (Jeremiah 1:5)*. He accepts the call of God and his consecration as a prophet, what puts him in a good state of mind. Several other words are addressed to him during his course. He is one of the prophets who suffered a lot from persecution, but he had a secret: he loved the Word of God that brought him comfort and joy to overcome trials: *« Your words were found, and I ate them; and Your words were to me a joy and the rejoicing of my heart, for I am called by Your name, O Lord God of hosts » (Jeremiah 15:16)*.

Prayers:

Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, enlighten the eyes of my heart and grant me the spirit of wisdom and revelation in your knowledge. I am willing to love your word and desire revelations. Amen!

SOME TIPS TO REMEMBER THE WORD'

he word inscribed in the Bible is inspired by God and useful for exhorting, teaching, edifying, instructing, etc.: «All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works» (2 Timothy 3:16-17). It is called 'LOGOS' in Hebrew, which means 'Letter'. You can learn to know it by heart, recite it but not be transformed because you read it with no interest, and with no purpose: « for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life» (2 Corinthians 3:6b). It is highly recommended to open the Bible with the desire to know God and not to know its story. You should open it with the attitude of someone who is hungry and who wants to eat good food that will strengthen him and support his stomach all the day. If you have not yet opened your heart to Jesus Christ, you will remain at the level of the letter, the knowledge of the scriptures; however, you will have to let Christ enter your life so that the Holy Spirit may tear the veil that prevents you from knowing God: « But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which vail is done away in Christ. But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the val is upon their heart. Nevertheless when it shall turn to the Lord, the vail shall be taken away. Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty» (2 Corinthians 3 :14-17).

The Word of God is the bread of life: *«I am that bread of life» (John 6:48)*. Bread is indicated in the morning for breakfast and during the day to accompany certain meals. It would be surprising to find that at a reception there is no bread on the table. It is consumed by all races, in all nations and by all ages. If you believe that God's word is spiritually similar to this physical bread, imagine that you go out without eating it: you will be hungry during the day. If it is not present on the table when you receive guests, the meal will be incomplete. This conception of the Word of God will arouse in you the desire to meditate on it (i.e. to consider it, to rehearse it all the time, to let it invade your thought, etc.). The Christian who does not read

the Bible does not grow spiritually and can be drawn into any wind of doctrines: « My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge» (Hosea 4:6a).

Get into the habit of noting what marked you during your daily meditation. Write in a notebook or on a piece of paper that you hang on a wall in order to constantly reread it. If possible, display it in a place you look at every day (next to the mirror, at the bedside, on the dashboard of your car, etc.):

«...Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry» (Habakkuk 2:2-3).

Ask God in your prayers for a word that attests to the dream you may have had and that presented a situation to you. Do not take this dream as a revelation especially when the situation it presents is contrary to the Word of God and particularly to what God has told you. To avoid the pitfalls of dreams, you must ask God to grant you the discernment of spirits and the interpretation of visions. Do not rely on a vision that is not supported by a Word of God. And if you make it a habit of declaring 'God told me' from a dream, you run the risk of falling into divination and making false prophecies.

It is also important to have partners in your Christian walk, people with whom you share meditations and who can remind you of what God said when you falter in faith: *«Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up!* » (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10).

Prayers:

Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I open my heart and my mouth so that you may fill them with your Word. I bless you for all the revelations. Amen!

The purpose of this convention is that you should be aware of your identity in Christ, the power of your new nature and its manifestation on earth. God's plan for you is to transform you so that you become a supernatural being and reign with Him (the Holy Spirit) on this earth while awaiting the return of Jesus Christ: "And [now] they sing a new song, saying, You are worthy to take the scroll and to break the seals that are on it, for You were slain (sacrificed), and with Your blood You purchased men unto God from every tribe and language and people and nation. And You have made them a kingdom (royal race) and priests to our God, and they shall reign [as kings] over the earth!» (Revelation 5: 9-10 AMPC).

The divine supernatural is all that is above the forces and laws of nature. Jesus Christ showed how to manifest it: He changed water into wine (John 2: 3-11), thus defying the normal process of making wine. He walked on water finding a perfect balance without resorting to the elements of nature ... Wow!

Hung by men on the cross, he despised no one, He promised no revenge to His detractors, but He did something amazing: He forgave humanity. Where one could expect hatred, he gave love. Instead of pride related to His position as the only begotten Son of God, He made no reference to His position but did not stop glorifying His heavenly Father. He performed acts that require divine action. «For you are becoming progressively acquainted with and recognizing more strongly the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, [in] that though He was [so very] rich, yet for your sakes He became [so very] poor, in order that by His poverty you might become enriched» (2 Corinthians 8: 9). He was rich in power, dominion, authority, favors, money, etc. He agreed to empty Himself from all those things and gave them to us. By the sacrificial act of the cross, by His death and resurrection, He offered His spirit and riches to whoever accepts Him. He thus gave you what He had to manifest the divine supernatural while still being in your mortal body and He announced the beginning of a new era. Glory to God! «...All authority (all power of rule) in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Go then and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Teaching them to observe everything that I have commanded

you, and behold, I am with you all the days, to the [very] close and consummation of the age» (Matthew 28: 18-20 AMPC).

Therefore, you are called to continue the work of Jesus Christ on earth: You have received the power to love your enemies, do it! You have received the power to heal the sick, to resurrect the dead; be conscious, get up and act. Just believe that the one who fulfills the will of God is in you: The Holy Spirit. You do not have to look at yourself but to believe in His power and ability to make everything possible. Apostle Paul said *«I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me» (Galatians 2:20a KJV).* He was very aware of his divine nature and understood the mechanism of manifestation of the divine supernatural. That is why he would not shrink from any situation if it had not been forbidden to him by the Holy Spirit *«And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid them on the fire, there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand... And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm» (Acts 28: 3-5).*

The divine supernatural begins with your transformed being and your life that looks like an open Bible. Your character is like Christ's, LOVE. Your testimony must bring a multitude to conversion; that is bearing fruit.
