THE VISION 'MERCREDI EN MONTAGNE'

Mercredi en Montagne is a movement inspired by God for the restoration of lives and families. It works in prayer cells.

Through this movement, God takes a person into darkness, presents Jesus Christ to him, follows him up so he may be transformed and manifest the character of Christ. His life becomes a testimony that favors the salvation of his loved ones (family, neighbor, colleague etc.). Only the Word of God unites all the persons who get connected to this program. All religious practices are not considered there. It welcomes anyone, believer or not, and allows everybody to start or continue serving God in their own church.

Under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, edification themes are developed every month in a booklet that is multiplied and distributed for free and the Lord raises in his people a spirit of devotion and sacrifice for His glory; it is the reason why the edification meetings are held every Wednesday afternoon in the different prayer cells (Douala, Yaounde, Bafoussam, Bagangte, Bamendjou, Bangou, Ebolowa, Kribi, Garoua, Foumban, Bertoua, Edea, Kouoptamo, Baïgon and Longueuil in Canada). Anyone connected to this ministry must fast every Wednesday to fellowship with the group and pray.

To spread the Gospel through the booklets and cover all the nation remains our challenge. Lives, families, couples are restored; business leaders are won over to Christ and impact their activities. Intense prayer programs multiply throughout the year to raise true intercessors. The website www.mercredienmontagne.com as well as an application 'MEM' are available. The vision progresses according to this divine instruction: **« Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back; lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes. For you will spread out to the right and to the left; your descendants will dispossess nations and settle in their desolate cities» (Isaiah 54: 2-3).**

PROCLAMATIONS FOR OCTOBER 2019

Every beginning of the month, show faith in God by giving Him many thanks for what He has planned in your life, in the movement *Mercredi en montagne* and in your nation during the month to come. Possess the fruit that God has produced for the month (blessings) according to **Revelation 22:2** « *Through the middle of the Broadway of the city; also, on either side of the river was the tree of life with its twelve varieties of fruit, yielding each month its fresh crop; and the leaves of the tree were for the healing and the restoration of the nations* ».

I give thanks to God the Father, who makes me happy in the covenant I made with His Son Jesus Christ. Covenant to which I remain faithful in all its principles. I choose to believe what His Word says for me and I possess all my blessings in this month of October 2019. I believe this and I confess with my mouth these words of blessings:

1- I am like a tree planted by the waters, and that spreads out its roots towards the river. I do not see and fear when heat comes, and my leaf remains green. In the year of drought, I am not anxious, and I keep bearing fruit. (Jeremiah 17:8).

2- I am healed from all forms of illness and infirmity by the stripes of Jesus Christ at the cross (Isaiah 53:5).

3- I enjoy the labor of my hands, I am happy and I prosper. My wife is like a fruitful vine in the very heart of my house; my children are like olive plants all around my table. I am blessed so, because I fear the Lord; the Lord blesses me out of Zion, and I see the prosperity of Jerusalem all the days of my life. I shall see my children's children (Psalm 128: 2-6).

4- After sowing in tears, I reap with songs of joy and in abundance, in all areas of my life (spiritual, material, financial, professional, etc.). (Psalm 126:5)

5- I am a crown of glory, a royal diadem in the hand of my God. I shall no longer be termed Forsaken, nor shall my land any more be termed Desolate, but I shall be called Hephzibah [My delight is in her], and my land shall be called Beulah [married]; for the Lord delights in me, and my land shall be married [owned and protected by the Lord]. (Isaiah 62: 3-4).

6- The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, and His words which He has put in my mouth, shall not depart from my mouth, nor from the mouth of my children, nor from the mouth of my children's children (Isaiah 59:21a).

7- I am more than a conqueror, Jesus Christ has overcome death and all its works in my life (illness, divorce, hatred, rejection, failure, limitations, infertility, barrenness, divisions, etc). (Revelation (5:5).

PROCLAMATION FOR THE MANIFESTATION OF FAITH

«Did I not tell you and promise you that if you would believe and rely on Me, you would see the glory of God? » (John 11:40). Jesus Christ challenges His people about faith in His Word. It's all about strengthening your faith and demonstrating it at all times and in all circumstances. Proclaim the following words from Bible verses:

1- In Christ, I have the firm assurance of the things I hope for (healing of my body, healing of my soul, reconciliation, conversion of a loved one, spiritual maturity, marriage, childbirth, promotion, love, repayment of debts, restoration, prosper in my work, deliverance of my children, etc.), And I demonstrate through my behavior and acts, those that I do not see. (Hebrews 11: 1)

2- Contrary to hope, I choose to believe in hope; I refuse to weaken in faith; I do not consider that the situation is physically hopeless but, I am fully convinced that what God has promised, He is also able to perform. (Romans 4: 18-20).

3- I choose to cling to Jesus Christ and I keep looking to Him. Whatever the magnitude of the storm, the strength of the wind that may blow on my life, my home, my family, my ministry, my activities, I remain at rest, relying on His Word and fixing my gaze on Jesus Christ who is always with me. (Matthew 8: 23-27).

4- I fear nothing, for the Lord is with me. I do not look around me in terror and I am not dismayed, for He is my God. He strengthens me, He helps me. He holds me up with His victorious right hand. (Isaiah 41:10)

5- No one is able to stand before me all the days of my life; the Lord is with me, as He was with Moses; He does not leave me, nor forsake me. (Joshua 1: 5).

6- I know that the Lord can do all things, and that no thought of His can be restrained. Nobody can hide His plans for my life, for the movement *Mercredi en montagne*. (Job 42: 2-3).

7- Upon my life, my blood family, my Christian family, the movement *Mercredi en montagne*, the right hand of the Lord is exalted! The right hand of the Lord does valiantly! I shall not die but live, and shall declare the works of the Lord. (Psalm 118: 16-17).

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 02, 2019

'FAITH POSSESSES WHAT GOD GIVES'

The Lord is a good Father; when you go through the Old Testament, you find many promises He made to His people. You will notice that verbs are much more conjugated in the future tense. He said to Abraham, «***I will bless you, and I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore***» (*Genesis 22:17 NKJV*). He said to Joshua, «***No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you***» (*Joshua 1: 5 NKJV*). Before Christ, He used to announce what He would do, with conditions: «***Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that the Lord your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God***» (*Deuteronomy 28: 1-2 NKJV*). But, you will see in the New Testament, after the coming of Christ, the verbs used are much more put in the present or the simple past tense. He said to the disciples: «***and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age***» (*Matthew 28: 20b NKJV*). Or «***Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you*** » (*Luke 10 :19 NKJV*). A way of saying: it's already done! What I promised in Abraham, I have already given! Before Jesus-Christ God had promised, through Jesus Christ He gave. By receiving Christ then, you receive your inheritance. Glory to God! He said: «***... IT IS FINISHED***» (*John 19:30a NKJV*).

Indeed, Jesus the Messiah is in Himself the fulfillment of God's promises for His people: «***And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed***» (*Genesis 12: 3b NKJV*). He is the blessing promised in Abraham. All you have to do is to open your heart to Him so that you instantly become 'entitled' to all His blessings. But, the fundamental question is this: '***Do you believe God?***' If you believe, you possess what He says.

It is written: «***Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality***» (*Hebrews 11:1 AMP*). Concretely, faith is not the hope for what you will have, but it is the assurance that you

already have what you are waiting for. What did God tell you about your health, your marital life, your family, your finances, a specific situation? Take it with joy and thanksgiving! Seize the revelation! Accept in your mind the answer He gives you and it will happen physically! Anne experienced this: as she had spent years waiting for a child in her womb, one day she went to the temple and prayed for long. Despite her pastor's wrong analysis of her physical state (he took her for a drunk woman), she received and believed the answer to her prayer: **« Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant your petition which you have asked of Him » (1 Samuel 1: 17b NKJV).** That is the word which created a child in Anne's womb simply because she believed it to be true, God gave her the child that she came to ask Him and she possessed it: **« So the woman went her way and ate, and her face was no longer sad » (1 Samuel 1: 18b NKJV).** How many times has God given you and you have not possessed because you looked to the person who spoke to you and not to God! Sometimes you doubted what you heard, you reasoned.

« Wait and listen, everyone who is thirsty! Come to the waters; and he who has no money, come, buy and eat! Yes, come, buy [priceless, spiritual] wine and milk without money and without price [simply for the self-surrender that accepts the blessing] » (Isaiah 55: 1 AMP). The way God offers you to get your promises is not money but THE FAITH. This is the currency needed to own your inheritance: **« Therefore it is of faith that it might be according to grace » (Romans 4: 16a NKJV).** Jesus Christ used to gauge the faith of the people He met by asking them quite simple questions: **« Do you believe that I am able to do this? » (Matthew 9: 28b NKJV).** It was a way of claiming the currency that was used to buy the promise! It's as if He was asking: Do you have the amount or the dose of faith necessary to possess sight, you two blind men? Beloved, do you have the dose of faith necessary to obtain what you expect from God?

Prayer:

Father, blessed are you for your faithfulness. I gladly receive your word revealed in the name of Jesus Christ. I believe you will do what you've promised me, Amen!

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 09, 2019

'CHOOSE TO BELIEVE GOD'

In all things, be determined! In Christ especially, be determined to follow Him, to serve Him, to worship Him. In this determination, you will find the strength to move forward, no matter the mountains that may stand before you. Job is a strong testimony of determination: as he was suffering excruciatingly from a serious illness that gnawed at his bones, the rejection of his wife and the insults of his friends (read Job 19: 1-24) , he remained serene about God his creator, determined to believe that his situation will change: **« For I know that my Redeemer lives, And He shall stand at last on the earth; And after my skin is destroyed, this I know, That in my flesh I shall see God, Whom I shall see for myself, And my eyes shall behold, and not another. How my heart yearns within me! » (Job 19:25-27 NKJV)**. Job chose to believe God. What about you, beloved? Who do you choose to believe? Do you believe the problem and consider it serious enough to reverse God's plan for your life? Do you choose to believe your entourage who comes to give you all kinds of advice? Do you choose to believe the devil and his agents who absolutely want to show you that they are powerful? Who do you choose to believe?

The divine nature you have received does not protect you from trials, hardships, persecutions or temptation: **« Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution » (2 Timothy 3: 12 NKJV)**. Jesus Christ went through all kinds of persecutions and trials. He went through all the stages of suffering during His earthly ministry but he overcame them all. His nature in you gives you the ability to dominate and triumph over all these difficult situations; it gives you wisdom and allows you to have the right attitude when facing each situation. Above all, it reinforces your FAITH. **« Beloved, do not be amazed and bewildered at the fiery ordeal which is taking place to test your quality, as though something strange were befalling you. But insofar as you are sharing Christ's sufferings, rejoice, so that when His glory is revealed, you may also rejoice with triumph [exultantly]. If you are censured and suffer abuse [because you bear] the name of Christ, blessed are you, because the Spirit of glory, the Spirit of God, is resting upon you » (1 Peter 4: 12-14 AMP)**. If you receive the divine nature, do not expect to experience less

trial or persecution; on the contrary, be determined to show it whatever the adversity. Choose to have the right attitude, that of Christ, before each situation. He, the Son of God, forgave at the painful moment of His crucifixion; you too, forgive all those who crucify you in a disguised way. He kept silent before His accusers; you too, choose to remain silent, without murmuring, without bitterness, when you are insulted or slandered. As Christ with Judah the traitor, let God avenge you from your enemies. By so doing, you make the choice to believe God: **« For this very reason, applying your diligence [to the divine promises, make every effort] in [exercising] your faith to, develop moral excellence, and in moral excellence, knowledge, and in your knowledge, self-control, and in your self-control, steadfastness, and in your steadfastness, godliness, and in your godliness, brotherly affection, and in your brotherly affection, [Christian] love. For as these qualities are yours and are increasing [in you as you grow toward spiritual maturity], they will keep you from being useless and unproductive in regard to the true knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. For whoever lacks these qualities is blind—shortsighted [closing his spiritual eyes to the truth], having become oblivious to the fact that he was cleansed from his old sins» (2 Peter 1:5-9 AMP).**

Choose to believe God and refuse to believe the devil with his lie. What does God say for each case of trial? choose to look into His Word, choose to focus on Him and wait for Him: **« He who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does» (James 1: 25 NKJV).** As a reflex, get into the habit of analyzing each situation in the light of the Word of God, meditate on it and choose to believe what it says. Proclaim this Word regularly until the victory becomes physical.

Prayer:

Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I give you thanks for this exhortation. I choose to believe you and I remain determined like Job to trust in you, no matter the adversity. I show my divine nature. Amen!

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2019**'WHATEVER THE CASE, GOD IS FAITHFUL'**

One thing is fundamental: God is faithful! A Christian who does not believe in God's faithfulness cannot prosper in his Christian walk. His name is Faithful: *«Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: King Of Kings And Lord Of Lords» (Revelation 19: 11-16 NKJV).* Wow!

God is faithful to His Word. He just needs to speak, to announce a plan, nothing can resist Him, it will certainly be fulfilled: *«The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations» (Psalm 33:11 NKJV).* You can be an obstacle to God's plan at a certain time; He will disqualify you and position another person to fulfill His Word. King Saul, anointed by God through Prophet Samuel, was disqualified for the benefit of King David, anointed by the same prophet. God had a plan of deliverance of the people of Israel from the hands of the enemy; this plan was to be performed with or without King Saul: *«But now your kingdom shall not continue; the Lord has sought out [David] a man after His own heart, and the Lord has commanded him to be prince and ruler over His people, because you have not kept what the Lord commanded you» (1 Samuel 13:14 AMP).* Caution! Know that 'In any case, God is faithful! His word is always fulfilled, with or without you!' Hurry to do what God expects from you, it's a grace. We should recognize that God's plan, as small as it may be, is always destined for the salvation of a multitude of people. Even if it is a child you are expecting, behind that child's life is hidden the destiny of a multitude. Anne sighed before God and desired a child, while the Lord needed a prophet because His word was rare; He needed a pure channel to speak righteously to His people: *«Now the boy Samuel ministered to*

the Lord before Eli. And the word of the Lord was rare in those days; there was no widespread revelation » (1 Samuel 3:1 NKJV).

God found Anne to have His plan performed. If Anne got discouraged, He would have found another person. No one is indispensable.

Also, God is faithful! His Word contains the necessary power to bring all things to existence, it is the sword of the Spirit (Ephesians 6:17b). The Word may seem simple or insignificant, but it contains what it announces. When Jesus Christ said to the king's officer « ***...Your son lives» (John 4:50a)***, He uttered just three little words, He did not raise a long prayer and that was enough to wake the dead child! In this word was hidden the life of the child, glory to God! And since the Word does not return to God without having fulfilled His purpose, it transported life and communicated it to the child through the channel of his father: « ***So shall My word be that goes forth out of My mouth: it shall not return to Me void [without producing any effect, useless], but it shall accomplish that which I please and purpose, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it» (Isaiah 55:11 AMP)***. The king's officer, the child's father, was just the contact point needed to communicate life to the child: « ***And as he was now going down, his servants met him and told him, saying, "Your son lives!" Then he inquired of them the hour when he got better. And they said to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him." So the father knew that it was at the same hour in which Jesus said to him, "Your son lives." And he himself believed, and his whole household» (John 4:51-53 NKJV)***. The FAITHFULNESS of God met the FAITH of the king's officer and the divine supernatural happened: the instant awakening of the child, life as Jesus Christ had announced.

Prayer:

Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I realize that you are faithful. It does not depend on me or on the circumstances, but you do not deny yourself: what you say, you do. Thank you for your faithfulness in my life. Amen!

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2019**'GOD IS ABLE TO FULFILL WHAT HE HAS PROMISED'**

God tests His children through more or less strong trials to see if they are really committed to obeying Him, if they really love Him, and what dose of faith they have. Abraham became a model of faith mentioned in the Bible several times because he braved very difficult trials. God declared him righteous, not because of obedience to the law, but because of his faith: **«*Abraham believed in (trusted in) God, and it was credited to his account as righteousness*» (Romans 4:3b AMP)**. He understood and realized that God is great! Father Abraham had the revelation of the greatness and the omnipotence of God. Indeed God is not a god at a human dimension, nor a god of circumstance, much less a god unable to do the impossible, no! **GOD IS GREAT AND ALMIGHTY**. He is greater than any situation, than any man, than the whole universe: **«*Who has measured the waters in the hollow of His hand, Measured heaven with a span And calculated the dust of the earth in a measure? Weighed the mountains in scales And the hills in a balance? Who has directed the Spirit of the Lord, Or as His counselor has taught Him? ...Behold, the nations are as a drop in a bucket, And are counted as the small dust on the scales; Look, He lifts up the isles as a very little thing*» (Isaiah 40:12-15 NKJV)**. He is infinitely GREAT. When you understand it, you step back before no difficulty because this great God came to you and made your body His home!

Knowing that God is great, being truly conscious of it and constantly remembering it will strengthen your faith. Yes, you need to have the full conviction that God, in His greatness, has the ability to fulfill all that He has promised: **«*No unbelief or distrust made him waver (doubtingly question) concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong and was empowered by faith as he gave praise and glory to God, Fully satisfied and assured that God was able and mighty to keep His word and to do what He had promised*» (Romans 4: 20-22 AMP)**. Like Abraham, be convinced of God's ability to fulfill all what He has promised to do in your life! What do you actually expect from Him? A glorious Christian life? A child and yet you are already practically menopausal? Marriage although you're already old? Healing? A gainful job? A powerful ministry? Restoration of your home? Your child's deliverance? What has God promised you? He tells you He has the ability to fulfill His plan for your life. It does not depend on you, but on His

faithfulness to His Word: if He said, He will do! It's your faith that is going to get everything, be patient!

What you experience daily is real, you see nothing coming on the horizon, sometimes you even look for a sign of the fulfillment of God's promise and you see nothing. Do not be incredulous, however; continue to believe in God's ability to physically achieve what He said. The reality is what you go through daily, what circumstances show you, what the environment imposes on you, but this reality has no strength before the truth which is the Word of God, God's promise for your life. Consider the truth at the expense of reality: « **who, contrary to hope, in hope believed, so that he became the father of many nations, according to what was spoken, "So shall your descendants be."** And not being weak in faith, **he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform**» (Romans 4 :18-21 NKJV).

No matter what your eyes see, what your body feels, what your ears hear, God has the ability to change everything with a click. He is the GOD ALMIGHTY! He who calls for existence what did not exist. He can create in a special way for a person who has price in His sight like you, all what He has promised: **«Who gives life to the dead and speaks of the nonexistent things that [He has foretold and promised] as if they [already] existed » (Romans 4:17b AMP).** So don't doubt, be convinced and wait.

Prayer:

Father, no one is like you, no one is comparable to you. Your greatness is limitless, your power is no longer to be proved. I am convinced that you can ALL and that nothing is impossible for you. I wait for you Lord, in the name of Jesus Christ, Amen!
