Message of the Lord: What if Jesus Christ comes back today?

From **John 14 :3** « *And if I go and make ready a place for you, I will come back again and will take you to Myself, that where I am you may be also*» (Amplified Bible)

Jesus Christ told you in John 14: 3 that He will prepare a place for you and that He will come back to take you.

But you have to stand firm until His return: « ***I am coming soon. Hold on to what you have, so that no one will take away your crown***» (Revelation 3:11). **What do you have to stand firm?**

Testimonies:

1- After receiving CHRIST, I preached the Gospel in my family-in law, but no one was willing to listen to me. I kept calm and continued with prayers, until the day my father-in-law fell seriously sick I went to his bedside and once again invited him to give his life to Jesus, he agreed. Following him, my sister-in-law also received CHRIST; we blessed the Lord. A few days later, my father-in-law passed away. I bless Heaven because he knew God before leaving this world.

2- I was unemployed for many years, I focused on seeking a job to make ends meet and I was asking God every day until a brother told me about Jesus; I agreed to receive Him. Thenceforth, I was living only for the Lord; He blessed me and I had a job interview. I was selected for a three-month trial. I got to work particularly by making suggestions to my boss for better performance; all my proposals were validated. After three weeks I was confirmed at my post, yet at the beginning I had to spend three months of test! GLORY TO YOU LORD.

Following these testimonies, if you also wish to have a new experience with God, open your heart to Him through this prayer: « ***Lord Jesus Christ, I make a covenant with you today. I open my heart to you and sincerely receive you. Fill me with your love. Reign totally in my life. Amen!*** ». You are therefore a child of God. Alleluia !

To spread the Gospel through the booklets and cover all the nation remains our challenge. Families, lives, couples are restored; business leaders are won over to Christ and impact their activities. The ministry '*prayer life*' is born: prayers are raised at waking hours (00 a.m., 3 a.m., 6 a.m., 9 a.m., 12 a.m., 3 p.m., 6 p.m., 9 p.m.) and many testimonies of healing, deliverance and life transformations are noted. The Lord prepares sentinels to watch. Intense programs multiply throughout the year to create impact. The websites www.mercredienmontagne.com, www.ChercheDieu.com and several expansion projects have been launched with the aim of spreading the gospel on the earth. The vision progresses according to this divine instruction: « **Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back; lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes. 

GOOD TO KNOW:

The gifts of the Spirit

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 1ST, 2020

'WHAT DO YOU HAVE TO STAND FIRM?'

What matters to any athlete who starts a race is to arrive a winner. This is also the desire of the Heavenly Father for each of His children: 'To arrive a winner in the heavenly kingdom': « ***To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne*** » (***Revelation 3 :21 NKJV***). The final victory, that is to say, "To be taken away on the return of the Lord Jesus Christ", requires a stable and firm Christian walk. It requires solid faith based on the true foundation which is Jesus Christ, which is the Word of God.

To be victorious, the athlete has his strength, his potions (energy drinks), his strong mind, his coach, etc. He has his supports. But you who awaits the return of Christ and who hope for the rapture, what do you have to stand firm? What do you have to resist temptation, not to be discouraged, not to go back to your past, not to deny God? Yes, what do you have to wait for the return of Jesus Christ? What are you leaning on? What makes your strength? « ***Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; But we will remember the name of the Lord our God. They have bowed down and fallen; But we have risen and stand upright*** » (***Psalms 20:7-8 NKJV***). King David knew on what to rely to win his daily battles; he called on the name of the Lord! You can choose to rely on the number of years you have spent in faith, on your experiences with God, on your Christian community or on your pastor, BUT you will remain vulnerable, you will look like a house built on the earth without a foundation and when the torrent will come, the house will not resist (Luke 6:49). When you will experience the slightest frustration in the midst of the Christians you lean on, you will falter in your walk and risk falling. Warning! Let go of your spiritual achievements and constantly seek the Word of God, that is to say the *Rhema* of God (the revelation of God). You will get it by reading the Bible daily, that is, by getting used to the *logos* (the written Word). Moses the great prophet had a reliable ally: the Word of the Lord: « ***... And I will be with your mouth and with his mouth, and I will teach you what you shall do*** » (***Exodus 4:15b NKJV***). He kept consulting the Lord who would speak to him and tell him all what to do. And you? What do you have to keep you firm until the return of Jesus Christ?

If all what you think you have is not the Word of God or His presence, analyze again your Christian walk. God gave you Jesus Christ who is the Word and His presence: « ***In the beginning the Word already existed. The Word was with God, and the Word was God... So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son***» (John 1:1, 14 NLT). The presence of God is most manifested in a Christian who reads the Bible daily. He makes the Word of God his daily bread and thus develops firm faith! (Read Roman 10:17).

What God gave you is His Word, don't underestimate it. Be aware of what it produces in you: ***Faith***, thus making you firm in your Christian walk. « ***Yes, I am the bread of life! Your ancestors ate manna in the wilderness, but they all died. Anyone who eats the bread from heaven, however, will never die. I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live forever***» (John 6 :48-51a NLT). In the daily bread there is the revelation of God Himself. If you eat it every day, you will have life, health in your body. Your knowledge of God and your love for Him will grow.

Meditating on the Word of God day and night according to the Lord's recommendation in Joshua 1: 8 is the only guarantee of success with God. It's the only way to activate the Holy Spirit that's in you. So the presence of God will qualify you for the rapture.

Prayer:

Father, thank you for your written word in the Bible. I declare in the name of Jesus Christ that it is to me a pillar on which I lean. It is the light that illuminates my path. I keep it precious, I cherish it and remain connected to it till eternity. In the name of Jesus Christ. Amen!

'HOLD FAST WHAT YOU HAVE TO STAND FIRM'

To him who overcomes ... This phrase is repeated several times in the revelations God gave to Apostle John. It is therefore clear that a Christian life is a life of constant battle and a crown is reserved for the winners. There is the struggle of evil thoughts, the battle of the flesh that must absolutely die and let the Holy Spirit act, the battle of the world seeking absolutely to bring you back to your past, the fight of the devil that prowls seeking to devour you. You have to always be equipped to not lose these battles and live your victorious Christian life. This is why Apostle Paul said: « ***I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing*** » (2 Timothy 4:7-8 NKJV). In other words, I accepted Jesus Christ; I walked according to His instructions despite all the opposition; I fulfilled my mission on earth, I was not discouraged. Now, I await my crown with confidence. Apostle Paul kept precious what he had received from the first day of his conversion: THE WORD OF GOD (Jesus Christ) « ... ***“Who are you, Lord?” Saul asked. And the voice replied, “I am Jesus, the one you are persecuting! Now get up and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do”*** » (Acts 9:5-6 NLT). Here is what Paul retained, the Word of Jesus Christ: *'Get up and go do what you will be told'*.

Do you remember what God said to you? What is the word that carries your call, your ministry and supports your Christian walk? What did God tell you which is sustained by a Bible verse? Hold on to it; it is very useful for you. When adversity comes, remember the revealed words and you will fight according to the rules: « ***And also if anyone competes in athletics, he is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules*** » (2 Timothy 2:5 NKJV). The fight rules are contained in the Bible. So you should have a life of sustained meditation in order to receive divine instructions.

« ***Because you have obeyed my command to persevere, I will protect you from the great time of testing that will come upon the whole world to test those who belong to this world. I am coming soon. Hold on to what you have, so that no one will take away your crown.*** » (Revelation 3:10-11 NLT). The Lord clearly reveals that you must keep His word, it is essential

for the walk. Every day, you have to find a word that will accompany you during the day. This word will certainly protect you from evil, from misfortune, from the devil's traps and from all kinds of temptation. In any case, the Father will always give you a word that suits your circumstances. That is why Jesus Christ recommends this prayer: « ***Give us today the food (the Word) we need***» (***Matthew 6:11 NLT***). He knows you better than yourself; He knows what you need even before you ask Him. The Word of the day will be the one that will defeat your opponents of the day. Misfortune can happen, but the Word of God will guard you, strengthen you, sustain you, will continue to give you hope in the Lord. It is the Word that you have kept in your heart that distinguishes you and gives you value. So you have to ask a Word every day, read the Bible.

The heavenly Father is happy to see His children faithful to His instructions. « ***He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him*** » (***John 14:21 NKJV***). When you keep the Word, you prove your love to the Lord and in return, He equips you. He gives you revelations that will light up your path: « ***The entrance of your words gives light; It gives understanding to the simple***» (***Psalms 119:130 NKJV***).

Hold firmly the words of God revealed for your life and you will receive your crown at the coming of Christ.

Prayer:

Father, I give you thanks for the gift of Your Word. I keep it precious and I walk according to its instructions in the name of Jesus Christ.

I present the revealed Word to all my spiritual adversaries and proclaim victory in all the battles of my Christian life.

I remain strengthened and firm until the return of Jesus Christ. Amen.

NOTES

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 15, 2020**'HOW DO WE PRECIOSLY KEEP THE WORD?'**

Christian life is not a game of chance, it is the true LIFE, the manifestation of the presence of God in you! It is the proof that God exists and that He made the heart of Man His permanent dwelling (1 Corinthians 6:19). It is therefore to be taken very seriously. It's a very good thing to belong to a Christian assembly, to be part of a Christian movement, but it's not enough! You should belong to Christ and do His perfect will while you are alive! This is how life in Christ is summed up to: **« Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me is thrown away like a useless branch and withers. Such branches are gathered into a pile to be burned. But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted! When you produce much fruit, you are my true disciples. This brings great glory to my Father. I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love. When you obey my commandments, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father's commandments and remain in his love» (John 15:5-10 NLT).**

In view of the above, the Lord is telling you that obeying God is essential. A Christian who does not obey does not do His will and he withers and dies (spiritually and sometimes physically). So you have only one choice to make in order to live with Christ for everlasting: Obey divine instructions! In other words, listen and practice. It's only by reading the Bible daily that you can know His will and LIVE: **«But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God» (Matthew 4 :4 NKJV).**

Concretely, how can we preciously keep the Word of God? Well, * You have to read the Bible every day and learn from it for yourself: Eat the daily bread: « Study this Book of Instruction (Bible) continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it» (Joshua 1:8a NLT). You have to read the Bible by seeking God's will for your life. Always have a notepad to write your message from the reading of the day. The goal is not only to know the story of the Bible but to know God your Father. So, you must aspire for more knowledge of the Heavenly Father when you read the Bible; do not seek to read in order to teach or

impress your audience. Always ask the Lord to speak to you and learn from it. A person transformed by the Word of God becomes the practical Bible and the testimony of his life a great teaching.

*Whenever you write your message of the day, you should make it a prayer topic. It will be a way to bring the revelation from your meditation into existence and fix what God said in your mind. You will have to take personal retreat moments. During these retreats, far from any distraction, you will grasp the will of God. There is a continuation of the Lord's ideas for your life. The messages line up like words in an audible voice. You will find that God speaks!

*And when you have prayed, you will have to share with others the bread of the day, what God says in the Bible (EVANGELISE). When you eat the right meal, you should also give it to others. You shall set the Word more in your mind.

Here is a good tip to keep the Word: Writing Bible verses and displaying them in the places you frequent most every day (doors, hallways, mirror, bedside, etc.) in order to keep them in your visual field: « ***You are my portion, O Lord; I have said that I would keep Your words*** » (***Psalm 119 :57 NKJV***). The Word of God is a treasure for a Christian who wants to know his Heavenly Father: « ***He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him***» (***John 14:21 NKJV***).

Prayer:

Heavenly Father, in the name of Jesus Christ, I submit to the authority of Your Word. I keep it precious by leading a growing life of prayer and meditation in the name of your Son Jesus Christ. Amen !

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 22, 2020**'GOD RECOMMENDS FAITHFULNESS'**

God wants you to be faithful to Him! « *Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life* » (*Revelation 2:10b NKJV*). He paid a very great price for your salvation: The sacrifice of His Son (John 3:16). He has thus shown His great love for you. So do not play with God, be grateful and prove it by remaining faithful to Him. Start by being faithful in your human relationships, your commitments (financial, service, etc.), your responsibilities (as head of the family, parent, child, etc.). Be faithful to your spouse, to your business partner (don't cheat on him/her, don't betray his/her trust): « *He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much; and he who is unjust in what is least is unjust also in much. Therefore, if you have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches?* » (*Luke 16:10-11 NKJV*). Faithfulness also means truth, uprightness, punctuality, integrity, loyalty, honesty. These are the values that you should advocate and which will prove that you are a faithful person.

« *Then the Lord said to Satan, "Have you considered My servant Job, that there is none like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, one who fears God and shuns evil?"* » (*Job 1:8 NKJV*). God testifies of a man called Job. He highlights his qualities: Integrity, righteousness, respect for God, honesty; in other words, Job is faithful. He loved God and selflessly served Him. The great losses of his life (children, property, health) did not taint his loyalty. Deep in the pain, Job made a very strong statement: « *For I know that my Redeemer lives, And He shall stand at last on the earth; And after my skin is destroyed, this I know, that in my flesh shall see God, Whom I shall see for myself, And my eyes shall behold, and not another. How my heart yearns within me* » (*Job 19 :25-27 NKJV*). What is the ordeal you are going through right now? What are the difficulties of your life? What are the thoughts that you develop? Whatever the situation: BE FAITHFUL! Don't change your behavior! Always be true, honest and loyal. Do not try to make ends meet by juggling; don't get mean, accusing men or God. Do not flee from trials but rejoice in being in Christ and faithful: « *So be truly glad. There is wonderful joy ahead, even though you must endure many trials for a little while. These trials will show that your faith is genuine. It is being tested as fire tests and purifies gold — though your faith is far more precious than mere gold. So when your faith remains strong through many*

trials, it will bring you much praise and glory and honor on the day when Jesus Christ is revealed to the whole world » (1 Peter 1:6-7 NLT).

In this time of dispensation of divine grace, grasp the gift of faith in Jesus Christ and pray to be 100% faithful. Work to manifest all the values related to faithfulness (truth, integrity, honesty, uprightness, punctuality, accuracy, etc.). If there is an aspect of your life where you do not show fidelity, pray and make a firm decision to correct yourself. All these values are proof that you are a Christian: **« *Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness. For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion » (Ephesians 6:13-18a NLT).*** In other words, if you want to stay up, firm in your Christian walk and reach the goal, you must be determined to manifest the values related to faithfulness. They are proper weapons of spiritual battle. The problem of spiritual lapse does not always come from the devil but from your flesh which gives him power over your life.

So keep the FAITH, believe God, believe His Word: **« *So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God » (Romans 10 :17 NKJV).***

Prayer:

Father, I thank you for the gift of faith. I pray you strengthen me, I choose to be faithful and to manifest all the faithfulness-related values (truth, uprightness, honesty, punctuality, loyalty, etc.). In Jesus name, Amen.

Proclaim with faith the following words inspired by the Holy Spirit and give thanks to God who will certainly accomplish them each in His time (Mark 11:24).

- 3- I take possession of any place where I find myself according to the Lord's recommendation in Joshua 1 verse 3 and I bring the presence of God everywhere (name the places). His glory is shown by signs and miracles, for He is with me (Matthew 28: 20b).
- 4- In this season, I live total restoration and the Lord replaces in my life the years that the great army of locusts had eaten in the name of Jesus Christ (Joel 2:25). I proclaim the physical restoration of the movement '*Mercredi en montagne*', of each of my brethren in the faith.
- 5- In the name of Jesus, I declare that no one will stand before me. Any opposition to my destiny and to that of my brothers in Christ bows its knees at the mention of the name of Jesus (Joshua 1: 5).
- 6- I hold the Word of God in my heart so that I might not sin against Him (Psalm 119: 11). I adorn myself with good works in order to joyfully await the return of Jesus Christ and I refuse all kinds of distraction (Revelation 19: 7-8). I stay awake, I keep my zeal and my flame does not go out, in the name of Jesus.

 I live a year of spiritual power, glory, abundance, victory and I overcome all conflict situations of my life
 I show the character of Christ and I keep Him lifted upon my life.
 I manifest divine health and I serve the Lord with total devotion.
 I bless my family and all those around me. AMEN! PRAISE TO GOD!

GOOD TO KNOW: THE GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT

Since the Old Testament, God by His spirit equipped men in order to make them capable of doing extraordinary works for His service (Bezalel for manual technique and knowledge; Samson for his strength, Solomon for his wisdom; etc.). In the New Testament, from Jesus to the apostles, God reveals to us the different gifts He has made available to His people. And in His epistle of 1 Corinthians 12: 1-31, He clearly details that for us. (And Matthew 25: 14-30, Luke 19: 12-27, Romans 12: 6-8)

0. USEFULNESS OF THIS TEACHING

Matthew tells us about the parable of the talents (Matthew 25: 14-30) and we notice that each servant received at least one talent. And we also read: **«Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin» (James 4:17).**

The aim of this teaching is therefore to:

- Know the word of God
- Clarify the different gifts and the differences between the gifts
- Identify by the Holy Spirit the gift (s) which He has given to us and exercise it
- Use those gifts in the church

1. DEFINITION

A gift is a talent, excellence, a mine (according to Luke 19: 12-27), a demarcation. A gift is what allows us to do something specific better than other people. A gift is a present from God and this in perfect sovereignty. A gift is not the only result of an apprenticeship (we can learn everything, but it is not a gift, and the difference is clear between someone who was able to do by learning and the one who received from God). A gift is not a fruit. A gift is received, yet a fruit is worked out. A gift of the Spirit is a gift for the growth and edification of the church.

2. THE DIFFERENT GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT

Remember that everyone can exercise as such (for example, any Christian can prophesy). Apostle Paul tells us: **«For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues» (1 Corinthians 12: 8-10)**

Nine gifts which we consider as the main gifts are presented here. There are many other gifts of the Spirit.

- a) Major gifts (commonly called 'the 9 gifts of the Spirit')
- i. **Word of wisdom:** Ease of understanding, explaining, convincing, demonstrating divine things, advice, direction ...
 - ii. **Word of knowledge:** The depths of the Word of God; the secrets of a person; the destiny of a person (his future).
 - iii. **Faith:** faith of great challenges, supernatural faith (where everyone doubts). This gift is the prerogative of the apostles in particular.
 - iv. **Healing:** (illness, or infirmity) Healing without taking medication, healing the body, the soul (internal wounds of the past such as trauma, etc.), deliverances
 - v. **Miracle:** (surrealistic) Supernatural events (to stop the rain, to walk on water, etc.); Resurrection, Creation / re-creation
 - vi. **Prophecy:** Expression of the Rhema; Announcement of things to come.
 - vii. **Discerning of spirits:** Identification of which spirit dwells in a particular body, assessing the spiritual state of someone through a simple look.
 - viii. **Diversity of tongues:** Speaking in other languages (men's languages such as Mandarin, Latin, Greek, etc.); Speaking in tongues (language of angels, not intelligible)
 - ix. **Interpretation of tongues:** Translate (either the language of men or the language of angels), even hear the language of animals.
- b) Other gifts
- **To give:** to sacrifice your finances for the church or others
 - **To assist:** to get up easily to comfort, sympathize, etc.
 - **To administer:** to organize and manage men
 - **To sing**
 - **To serve:** in protocol for example

The list is non-exhaustive!!!

3. MISUNDERSTANDINGS

- Speaking in tongues: it is a gift like any other, so it is not an obligation. Otherwise, every Christian would be obliged to have all the nine major gifts without exception. And Apostle Paul questions about it: « **Do all have gifts of healings? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret? » Obviously not! (1 Corinthians 12:30).** This verse is so clear that it does not even need explanations.
- A gift can appear (or be revealed 10 years later), not necessarily the first day.
- The purpose of any spiritual gift is also equivalent to that of ministry: to serve in the church and / or for the church, not to serve oneself.
