Message of the Lord: What if Jesus Christ comes back today?

From **John 14:3** « And if I go and make ready a place for you, I will come back again and will take you to Myself, that where I am you may be also» (Amplified Bible)

Jesus Christ is coming soon, what a joy for him who has straightened up and who is walking in full awareness of his divine nature. If this is your case, then the rapture will not surprise you. However, this is what you should do: *« Delight yourself in the Lord » (Psalm 37: 4a NKJV)*.

'GOD IS LOOKING FOR HIS HOME'

hen you read the Bible from Genesis to Revelation, you see that the Lord has always assigned Himself a house on earth. A place where He stands to have relationships with men. He started with a geographical location, the Garden of Eden:

"Then the Lord God planted a garden in Eden in the east, and there He placed the man He had made." (Genesis 2: 8 NLT). In this garden God used to come to man's encounter, He could communicate with him, give him instructions. Likewise at the time of Moses, God asked him several times to meet Him on the mountain (Exodus 24:12), finally He asked the people to build Him a sacred tent where He would come to live among them:
"And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them."

(Exodus 25: 8). It is in this sacred tent called "the Tent of Meeting" that the Ark of the Covenant rested, it is there that the Lord descended whenever He wanted to speak to His people; it was the house of God.

When God's people moved, the tent had to be dismantled and rebuilt in the new place of residence. This is how things were done until the construction by King Solomon, of the temple of Jerusalem where people would come from everywhere to worship the Lord (1 Kings 6). Just as for the building of the sacred tent and the ark Moses had received very specific instructions, so also Solomon had built the temple according to the plans left by David his father.

However, the disobedience of the people of Israel repeatedly placed them under the yoke of their enemies and the temple was destroyed: « As the Lord had said beforehand, Nebuchadnezzar carried away all the treasures from the Lord's Temple and the royal palace. He stripped away all the gold objects that King Solomon of Israel had placed in the Temple» (2 kings 24:13 NLT). Yes, God is looking for His home. There was therefore no longer a place where God could come and speak with men.

Whenever the temple was destroyed, God would raise men to rebuild the temple. He always arranged for the temple to be rebuilt and the temple objects to be put back in their place. So in the days of Ezra, God awakened the spirit of King Cyrus to authorize the rebuilding of the temple: « Whoever is among you of all his people, may his God be with him, and let him go up

to Jerusalem, which is in Judah, and rebuild the house of the Lord, the God of Israel—he is the God who is in Jerusalem» (Ezra 1:3 ESV).

But God in His perfect plan had prepared His house before the foundation of the world, the place He had chosen for Himself and where He would dwell permanently with man. This is why in His plan of salvation He sent Jesus Christ to fully fulfill this plan. He had to find a way to speak with men no longer from mouth to mouth but from heart to heart: the Holy Spirit came. Wow! God has found His temple: « I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you» (Ezekiel 36:26a NKJV). God thus put His Heart and His Spirit in man.

However, even today God's house is not as He desires it to be; He has described it as: a royal palace, adorned with precious stones of all kinds, gold and diamonds, shining and brilliant. Its corridors are paved with gold and its walls covered with glittering stones, a house of celebration and rejoicing because of His presence. He walks, He searches and what He sees, some beautiful houses but which do not shine as they should, others dilapidated and dirty, still others in the swamps; or beautiful shiny but empty houses not furnished, others gloomy and sad with guests but no joy, and still others with greedy people doing service for money...: *« But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light» (1 Peter 2:9 ESV)*. This is the house of God. God is looking for His house; has He found it with you?

'HOUSE OF PRAYER = HOUSE OF FAITH'

dery often when we want to define someone, we look for the expression that will perfectly qualify them and for that we look at them in their character and habits, what they do the most. Likewise, when you want to learn to dance, you go to a dance hall. So, what can you do in a house of prayer? Pray. The house of prayer is the house that establishes relationships, relationship with God and relationship with men. However you have to be careful because who says relationship says AGREEMENT: ** Do two walk together, unless they have agreed to meet? ** (Amos 3:3 ESV). When you pray, make sure that you are in the will of God or that your prayer topic is in accordance with the Word of God. He says: ** And this is the confidence that we have toward Him, that if we ask anything according to His will He hears us* (1 John 5:14 ESV); always seek to be in the will of God, otherwise your prayer is an abomination (Proverbs 28: 9).

In a relationship when one speaks it is for the other to listen and respond: it is dialogue. The Lord simply wants you to acknowledge your sins and confess them humbly before Him. Be sincere: to acknowledge your sin is to recognize that you are not in His will or your request is not in accordance with His Word. If you do so, the barrier that separates you will fall: "Listen! The Lord's arm is not too weak to save you, nor is His ear too deaf to hear you call. It's your sins that have cut you off from God. Because of your sins, He has turned away and will not listen anymore" (Isaiah 59:1-2 NLT). Above all, do not feel guilty; you are already forgiven through the blood of Jesus. God is Love, He is good; feel free to speak to Him as to a father who is always ready to take you in his arms.

When you pray in His will, believe that He is listening to you and that He has answered you even if you do not see anything yet; it is FAITH: "And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him" (1 John 5:15 NKJV). The Lord wants men and women of faith, those who know Him and who know how to trust in Him completely (Mark 11:23). Yes, your prayer must be carried by your faith; it can undergo the tests of time but it will always end in victory and fulfillment.

When you pray, don't multiply words as if you are flattering or seducing: « When you pray, don't babble on and on as the Gentiles do, They think their prayers are answered merely by repeating their words again and again» (Matthew 6:7 NLT); but pray the Word, reminding God of what He says in His Word, and speak with sincerity of heart. You must believe that God has the capacity and the power to grant you what you ask of Him, He is the God who gives life to the dead: « That is what the Scriptures mean when God told him, "I have made you the father of many nations." This happened because Abraham believed in the God who brings the dead back to life and who creates new things out of nothing» (Romans 4:17 NLT). He says He created all that exists on the earth and that nothing was made without Him (John 1: 3); is anything too hard or too wonderful for the Lord? Nothing is impossible for Him, even if the situation had already rotten as the body of Lazarus or the sterility at an advanced age of Elisabeth the mother of John the Baptist, He is not a man, He is God and He can do all things: « For with God nothing is ever impossible» (Luke 1:37 AMPC).

Faith when it is manifested, rejoices the heart of God; so make a commitment to become a man or a woman of faith. The Word of God has given you the capacity to become, therefore faith resides in you, show it simply: « And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who seek Him» (Hebrews 11:6 ESV). You must believe that God is faithful, capable and you will receive your answer at the appointed time. Your house of prayer will make a very big impact and glorify the Lord.

Prayer:

Thank you Lord for the Holy Spirit who reveals and manifests faith in me. I declare as from now I am a man / woman who shows faith in prayer in the name of lesus Christ. Amen!

YOU ARE THE HOUSE OF PRAYER: TAKE CARE OF IT'

uilding a house requires preliminary work and a careful study, especially if the builder wants to build something solid and durable. You were made in the image and likeness of God. From the beginning you were prepared to be the dwelling place of the Trinity, the sacred tent, the temple of God: «For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: » (2 Corinthians 6:16b NKJV). So you have a main mission: to pray. The center of your house is the Ark of the Covenant, which is your heart; it is he who must contain the tables of the law, and the prescriptions of the Lord.

God gives you this recommendation, make your house a place of prayer, make your heart a place of encounter of your human spirit with the Spirit of God. Speak to God and listen to Him, focus your attention on God and on His Word.

Consecrate your physical house to prayer, where you live, your house must become a prayer altar, saturate the atmosphere 24 hours a day with praise and worship. Bring your family together daily to pray, to listen to the Lord and worship Him.

You are the house of prayer, to dedicate yourself to prayer is to commit yourself to being a channel through which the kingdom of God is manifested on earth. Your prayer will lay the hand of God on a life, incline the eye of God on a situation, set the foot of God on a site, and draw the breath of God in an action. In short, through your prayer, God acts in lives and in nations. This was the case with Tabitha also called Dorcas: *«But Peter put them all outside, and knelt down and prayed; and turning to the body he said, "Tabitha, arise." And she opened her eyes, and when she saw Peter she sat up» (Acts 9:40 ESV).* What a Grace! Peter agreed to be the channel and the Spirit of God moved.

You were born in Christ to be an ambassador, the one through whom Christ wants to transmit life, to reconcile men with God by bringing them His message of love and salvation: *«So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making His appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" » (2 Corinthians 5:20 NLT)*. You were born in Christ to be a priest (Revelation 5:10), an intercessor (1 Thessalonians 5:17).

To revive prayer in your life, your heart, in your house is to awaken the power of God; so get out of sleep, get out of heaviness, get out of laziness. If you don't pray for yourself, your family, your nation, your job, etc. nothing will happen according to God's perfect plan and you will spend the time complaining. Your prayer brings back life where there was death, it brings your projects and situations back to God's perfect plan: « Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known» (Jeremiah 33:3 ESV).

The time for Peter to die had not yet come, the enemy was prowling like a lion to stop his destiny and prevent him from doing the good works that God had planned for him to do. The Church began to pray and the day before his execution he was miraculously released from prison by the intervention of an angel: « And when Peter had come to himself, he said, "Now I know for certain that the Lord has sent His angel, and has delivered me from the hand of Herod and from all the expectation of the Jewish people"» (Acts 12:11 NKJV). Your prayer puts the angels in action.

The house of prayer like any house needs to be maintained, cleaned and adorned. Cast out thieves (anger, gossip, lack of forgiveness, drugs, sexual immorality, alcoholism, smoking, masturbation, pornography, bribery, cheating, homosexuality, quarrels, division, jealousy, etc.) who have been hiding in closets and under beds; they have done too much of their business: « God will destroy anyone who destroys this temple. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple» (1 Corinthians 3:17 NLT). Let the Holy Spirit take the whole place and accomplish the actions of healing and repair that must be done in lives.

Prayer:

Father, grant me the grace to take seriously the channel of restoration that I am and to take care of my house of prayer in the name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

'HOW TO BEAR FRUITS IN PRAYER?'

life of prayer is a life where the main characteristic is listening to the Lord and not a life where you spend most of the time talking. No! To pray is above all to listen, to contemplate, to adore. It is to have a relationship with God, to dialogue with Him, to come into His presence with an attitude of total submission to Him and ready to do His will. To pray is to accept that God will do His will and not yours. It is an attitude of the heart: to go before God agreeing to whatever He is going to say. Know that before being called to pray for others, you are first called to worship God: « And Jesus answered and said to him, "Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve'"» (Luke 4:8 NKJV).

This is recommended:

- Get into the habit of worshiping Him, contemplating Him, admiring His works, praising Him with songs, your own words, worshiping Him in spirit and with a sincere heart as David did: « O Lord, our Lord, your majestic name fills the earth! Your glory is higher than the heavens» (Psalm 8: 2 NLT).
- Take the habit of thanking Him in whatever situation you are going through; He is faithful: « give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus » (1 Thessalonians 5:18 NIV).

What you must not do is to come directly with complaints, to come and impose your will or your plans on God, to scold or rebuke God. This is what Job did and it did not please God: « Then the Lord answered Job from the whirlwind: "Who is this that questions my wisdom with such ignorant words? Brace yourself like a man, because I have some questions for you, and you must answer them. "Where were you when I laid the foundations of the earth? Tell me, if you know so much"» (Job 38:1-4 NLT).

This is recommended to you:

- Develop a thirst to listen to God speaking to you, lend an ear to the Holy Spirit who always has something to say. During worship, pay attention to the words you hear in your mind. If you do not receive any word, open your Bible and read the text that is submitted to you. In any case, always reading a verse or an extract from the Bible, it is also listening to God and it is part of praying. The message intended for you will resound in your mind in a special way and will attract your gaze, it should be noted

immediately: « This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: 'Write in a book all the words I have spoken to you'» (Jeremiah 30:2 NIV).

What is not good is listening by looking at the lives of others, seeing yourself already perfect, telling yourself that it does not concern you. You must not listen with a distracted heart or refuse to take notes, telling yourself that your memory will retain everything: you risk forgetting.

This is still recommended to you:

- Pray and proclaim the word you have received, believe with all your heart what God has said to you, make it a prayer topic and let the Holy Spirit act until it is answered: *« Truly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and thrown into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says will come to pass, it will be done for him » (Mark 11:23 ESV)*.

What you must not do is to receive a Word and keep silent: the Holy Spirit needs your mouth to act. You don't have to focus on setting the time of fulfillment, counting the hours, days, and months. You risk getting discouraged and giving up.

Finally, it is recommended to intercede for others, your country and the world, carry the burdens of souls and commit to praying until it is answered:

« Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ»
(Galatians 6:2 NLT). It is not good to pray only for yourself, your family, your needs etc. because the love of God poured into your heart has to push you to pray for others: « o whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin » (Jams 4:17 ESV). Do what rejoices the heart of God; this is how you will bear fruit in your prayers.

Prayer:

Heavenly Father, I thank you for the guidance you are giving me today. I declare that I now bear fruit in my prayers in the name of Jesus Christ Amen!

It's a matter of devoting one to two Wednesdays per month to raise families before the throne of grace (Hebrews 4:16), pray for salvation (John 6:44), pray for reconciliations in couples and families (2 Corinthians 5:18-20), pray for sincere forgiveness, that God's love should ablaze hearts. Pray for hunger for the Word and thirst for God in hearts (Amos 8:11). Pray and destroy any opposition to the glorious destiny of couples and families (Isaiah 54:17; Joshua 1: 5).

Some verses to proclaim for the family:

- 1-Father, my family and I have sinned against you; I admit our transgressions towards you; wash away the penalty of our sins and heal us. (Psalm 32:5). I do not hide our iniquities from you (list them), I confess them before you, grant my family your mercy (Proverbs 28:13)
- 2- Father in the name of Jesus Christ, fulfill the promises you said about my couple and my family, renew your covenant with us again (Genesis 17:7). And grant us the grace to live them (Acts 16:31)
- 3- Father, let the blood of Jesus Christ cancel all the consequences of bad words spoken against my couple, my children, my family and may this blood rather speak in our favor. (Hebrews 12:24)
- 4- Father, replace the years that the devourer had taken to my couple, to each member of my family and to our projects. By the blood of Christ, I close the door to the angel of death, to the plague, to the devourer and to the destroyer (Joel 2:25 and Exodus 12:23-24).
- 5-By the blood of Jesus, the curse has been removed from my family, the light of Christ now enlightens my couple, my family and salvation is received by my spouse as well as by each member of my family in the name of Jesus Christ (Acts 26:18).
